**Chair, Phil Hafer called the meeting to order at 12:05 PM**

Vice Chair O'Donnell, Cutler motioned to approve the minutes, Board Member, Lincoln 2<sup>nd</sup>  
All in favor.

**ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION:**

Airport Manager, Carberry discussed the consideration of a contract between City of Twin Falls and Riedesel Engineering for design and construction services for two projects: The fog seal & remaking of RY7/25. If additional discretionary funds are available, work will commence on pavement reconstruction of the east ramp, terminal air carrier ramp & 4 northwest taxi lanes. City Ex Officio, Munn asked about the different treatments that are used for pavement sealing. Airport Manager Carberry answered that the fog seal is a lighter application than a slurry seal, a light mist, in order not to choke the porous friction surface of the runway. He also explained they are designing the work to include the pavement reconstruction if the additional discretionary dollars become available. If the funding is not available, we will delay some of the work until next season. Board Member Lincoln moved that the Airport Advisory Board recommend approval of the contract between the City of Twin Falls/Twin Falls County and Riedesel Engineering. Vice Chair, O'Donnell 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor.

**STATUS REPORT:**

Airport Manager, Carberry discussed the SRE (Snow Removal Equipment) building and that it will break ground sometime in March or April, depending on the weather.

Airport Manager, Carberry discussed the air service agreement that he and Chamber of Commerce Shawn Barigar have been working on, and the utilization of the DOT Grant to expand service this spring. The negotiations with SkyWest have been positive and we hope to have more specific information by mid - late February. The City has a \$500,000.00 Grant to use for this and

the Chamber will be soliciting funds for advertising the new service. The airport has allocated \$10,000.00 of their advertising funds in addition to what the Chamber is able to raise, for a total of 65,000.00

Board Member, Lincoln and Chair, Hafer both praised Bill Carberry and chamber President, Shawn Barigar for all of their hard work on moving forward toward a new air service capacity to Salt Lake City and what a great asset it is to the community.
