MINUTES

Chairperson Gale Kleinkopf called the meeting to order at 11:00 am.

Item # 1 Approve minutes of the April 10th, 2013 meeting.

Rich Birrell made a motion to approve the minutes and Jack Jardine seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Item #2 Fund Raising Golf Tournament Update

Rich Birrell asked everyone to put together their top ten people/organizations of who they would like to contact and work off the list Dennis provided or anyone you might know or whoever might want to put a team together. Please identify how your contact wants to donate 1) if they want to be a tee sponsor (\$200), 2) if they want to be a tee sponsor and have a team (\$300) 3) if they just want to donate something to the raffle and 4) just be a team on their own(\$50 per player). We will have a 25 team max.

- A letter will be drafted and handed out to the men's and women's golf associations for the participation in the tournament.

- Travis will have raffle tickets and posters ready by the 22nd of May.
- Gale will talk to Jensen's Jeweler's for their donation.
- Nikki will mail out letters to past sponsors. Sponsor names will be emailed to Nikki to compile and distribute a current sponsor list.
- Steve to provide a list of members, players with season passes, or people who play out there a lot.

We will have a meeting in two weeks, May 22nd at 11:00am at the golf course. Please bring all your ideas to this meeting.

There was a discussion on possibly doing a hole in one with a prize.

Work on tee box 14 is completed and we will be working on tee box 11.

Item #3

Budget Requests for 2013-2-14

Dennis went over the capital improvements for next year's budget by priority.

- Upgrade the Fire Suppression System in the Kitchen
- Tables and Chairs for the Club House
- Replace the soffit under the eaves at the Club House
- Seal concrete patio deck at the Club House
- Add deck/patio out of the bar area at the Club House-this project will be a split project between the City and Steve Meyerhoeffer.

The Parks Department got a new lawn mower and the one currently at the golf course will stay there. This mower will be used to mow the rough.

Steve indicated that there are three main goals they are working on, 1) Trim trees along the fairways, 2) put compost on the fairways, and 3) work on the bunkers to allow rain and irrigation water to drain through them. For next year's project we are looking at making modifications on #18 green. The holes are either in the very front or very back because two thirds of the green can't be used because the slope is so severe. His thoughts were to close the back off and use the front for a month and as the sod kills off reduce the slope and put sod back on and wait month before we play it. He would like to have the option of moving the pins around.

Brett asked about the irrigation/sprinkler system and wanted to know if we might need to budget for improvements to that.

Item #4

Other Items from the Commission

Dennis asked the Commission if they wanted to work on long term goals and objectives for the Golf Course. Put together some long term ideas that we can present to the Council and let them know this is what we are looking at in the future. We can discuss this at next month's meeting.


