**TWIN FALLS GOLF ADVISORY COMMISSION MEETING**

**MINUTES**

Chairperson Gale Kleinkopf called the meeting to order at 11:10 am.

**Item # 1** **Approve minutes of the June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2013 meeting.**  
 Jack Jardine made a motion to approve the minutes and Rich Birrell seconded the motion.  
 Motion passed with a unanimous vote.

**Item #2** **Fund Raising Golf Tournament Update**  
 Dennis indicated that Dario and his crew have finished the work on the tee box at hole #14, and that sand has been placed in some of the bunkers. Brett Semple was not in attendance but wanted an update on the teams and sponsors to date. Travis indicated that they have about five teams signed up, three from previous years and two new teams. Teena has a team and a verbal on one. Rich has a verbal from the Pocket and he will be getting one or two teams from his group. Jack Jardine will have a team as well as Dennis.

Brett wanted to know if Ed had had a chance to check with Jensen Jeweler's on their raffle item. Ed has not been able to follow up so Dennis will be contacting Tony. Brett got the Rock Creek certificates lined up and some verbal commitments on teams.

Discussion on raffle items. As it is now the barbeque is out for display. Travis will be putting up a list by the door to help sell the raffle tickets. There was a discussion on selling a bigger package of tickets like a group of 50 or 100 at a special rate. It was decided that they would sell 12 tickets for \$50 and get a sleeve of Pro V balls with it. Jack also recommended that they make it a contest between golf employees so that the big seller gets a concession for selling the most tickets. Travis went over the items he has received from his vendors for the raffle.

Travis is going to talk to Kyle Mylie, a student, to hit your ball at tee # 10 for five dollars.

### **Item #3 Long Term Goals Discussion**

Dennis found some old minutes from 1997 that had some priorities listed for the Golf Advisory Commission as indicated on the staff report. He recommended some items that the Commission might want to discuss for long term goals as listed on the staff report.

Dennis covered one of the eight focus areas for the City's Strategic Plan which is the Healthy Community and one of the initiatives is; The City will provide programs and services that support healthy lifestyles. There are two objectives under this initiative that the golf course could focus on, 1) provide affordable healthy lifestyle programs for kids; and 2) reduce health risks through expansion of physical activity programs provided by the City and/or in partnership with others.

Another focus area is to have a Secure Community. One goal is to maintain safe public facilities and parks. One of the initiatives is; The City will ensure that all public facilities are safe.

Dennis recommended to the Commission the need to develop long terms goals for the golf course that deal with the course itself and ones that tie into the City's strategic plan especially with those two objectives under the Healthy Community focus area. There was discussion on Junior Golf and perhaps an Executive course. Dennis asked the Commission to email him or Nikki their ideas for the long term goals.

Council Woman Hawkins indicated that the City will be discussing what happens when the City reaches the fifty thousand population level. The Federal government has a whole set of guidelines in regards to vehicles driving on unpaved surfaces because of storm water runoff and things getting into our water that should not be there. There is an unpaved section at the golf course that we will need to address. We need to get everyone into compliance now.


### **Item #4 Other Items from the Commission**
