TWIN FALLS GOLF ADVISORY COMMISSION MEETING

MINUTES

Chairperson Gale Kleinkopf called the meeting to order at 11:10 am. A quorum was not present.

Item # 1 Approve minutes of the July 10, 2013 meeting.

Quorum was not present when minutes were discussed and will be addressed at the September meeting.

Item #2 Fund Raising Golf Tournament Update

The tournament generated, as 8-8-13, gross revenue of \$8,587. Sponsorship funds have not been collected from Watkins Distributing (invoice has been sent. The Commission was given a tour of the areas that will be considered for the funds generated from the golf tournament. The Commission tour included the following areas:

1. The flag pole area that had recently been sodded with grass
2. The water fountain, which is not broken but just needs to be hooked up, (It was noted that the original donors of the fountain will be in town and visiting to look at the fountain and the possible revamping of the fountain)
3. Tee #11 which has issues with the way it slopes in all directions, also remove a poplar tree in the fairway.
4. Tee #14 where the new tee was built.

5. Tee box #17 is not level and has a tier which eliminates the ability to have multiple tee off points
6. Green #18 has too much of a slope and placement of the hole can only be in the very upper or lower of the green.

Other areas of concern were discussed such as the sand traps at # 6, and #13. The #8 sand trap could be filled in to keep maintenance and costs down and move the sand to #15 where the sand is shallow. There was some discussion on eliminating the sand trap at #6 also. The cart paths were also discussed. Dario indicated that he did not have the proper equipment to enhance the cart paths. Dario was asked to get some estimates for the pouring concrete at the cart path on #10, from the blue tees to the women's tee. Councilwoman Hawkins suggested that the Golf Course get on the list to receive some of the used asphalt that will becoming available and using that in the cart areas.

Commissioner Jack Jardine left the Commission meeting at 11:45am. The Commission was unable to make any decisions on prioritizing as a quorum was not present.

Item #3 Long Term Goals Discussion

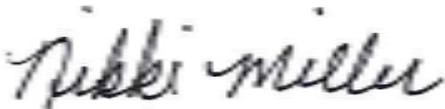
Dennis reviewed items that the Commission should discuss for long term goals and indicated that he wanted to have some goals documented and ready by March to present to the Council. He also recommended that a subcommittee be established to work on the long term goals. Dennis will send out an email asking for volunteers for this committee and Gary Roland volunteered to sit on the committee.

Item #4 Other Items from the Commission

Dennis indicated that the City will be improving city owned lots in the next month or so. The golf course overflow parking will be done as well as the Oregon Trail Youth Complex and one on the south side of Harmon Park.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:00 pm.
