**STATUS REPORT:**

Airport Manager, Carberry, presented a plaque to former Chair - Phil Hafer and thanked him for his many years of service on the board as well as his many years involved with the air show.

Airport Manager, Carberry, welcomed/introduced new board member Brady Workman.

Airport Manager, Carberry, discussed the fog seal and apron paving. They will begin work on the taxi lanes on the 20<sup>th</sup> and hope to be completed by Thanksgiving week. All tenants have been notified of access issues regarding their hangars.

Airport Manager, Carberry, discussed the upcoming airshow to be held June 21-23, 2014. He discussed the formation of a non-profit organization to transition the fiscal structure of the air show. The show in 2014 will be a smaller event than in 2012, no jet team demos. An airshow tickler event will be held October 17<sup>th</sup> at Reeder Flying Service.

Airport Manager, Carberry, discussed the tri-annual drill, held on September 18, 2013, they had 55 volunteers. Police, Fire, County, Salvation Army, St Luke's Air and St Luke's MVRMC were some of the organizations involved. Special thanks to board members Gene Turley and Bill Lincoln for stepping up to help with all the volunteers. The family response area was added to the drill scenario this year.

Airport Manager, Carberry, discussed the new air service agreement and how well it is doing. The first quarter invoice from SkyWest, showed no subsidy needed for the service.
