II. ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION

-Mayor Visit

Mayor Don Hall thanked us for our participation in the Youth Council. He informed us about how seasons in politics work and gave a City Council update.

We thanked him for coming and congratulated him on his appointment to Mayor.

-Vote in New Members and Treasurer

Jonah Ruf made a motion to vote in new members. Billy Bello seconded the motion. Due to the resigning of Julie Ruth Malone, Treasurer, a position as a new treasurer was elected. LaSalle LeBaron was nominated by Jonah Ruf and was nominated by Nolan Stroup. Harley Jo Wathen won the election.

- Fundraisers

LaSalle LeBaron was able to get 60 cases of hashed browns; this is enough to feed 120+ people. Jesse Stroup contacted several local chain stores and found out that we are not eligible for donations from them because we are NOT non-profit. Hannah Bello was unable to find the Farm Fresh egg company and is still in the process of acquiring donation applications from Falls Brand. Nolan Stroup contacted a few other possible donators. Billy Bello contacted the Senior Center and discovered that they would want 50% of the profit and \$150 of insurance. Harley Wathen contacted the Parish Hall and they would want \$105 of insurance and for us to clean up. We will take a vote on which establishment. Aricka Aquistipace volunteered to see about getting tickets through a friend.

- Adopting Part of the Canyon Trail

Jesse Stroup requested more waivers for Youth Council members under 18yrs old. After everyone (Under 18) has this signed the waiver and their parent or guardian has signed, Jesse will turn the application in to Parks and Recreation.

- Anti-Suicide Campaign

The Youth Council members voted to write speeches concerning suicides and take to schools. All but one member of the Executive Council wrote a speech. We are also excepting speeches from the other Youth Council members.

- Kite Day

We had a discussion on whether or not to buy as many flyers as we did last year, also we debated on if we should buy a total 350 Business flyers and 350 regular flyers. We decided against buying the total 350 business flyers (due to low attendance of businesses last year) and will only be ordering 50.

Kite Day has been set for May 10th-11th. Every member of the Youth Council is expected to come to one or both of the days.

Harley Jo Wathen is preparing our flyers this year. Jesse Stroup and Hannah Bello have agreed to go on radio stations and news stations to promote the event. Jesse Stroup has put the event on several community websites and radio station websites. You are asked to join the event on FB and to invite as many friends and family as possible. The games and times for games were decided, the Kite Day committee decided to make a prize for the first kite in the sky both days.

We will be going to businesses soon to ask for donations of gift certificates to give as prizes.
