ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION:

Presentation

Airport Manager, Carberry, introduced Major Ryan Behringer, Chief of Flight Safety, Mtn Home AF Base, and Officer John Cropper ATCT Mtn Home AF Base, regarding Mid- Air Collision Avoidance. Diversions and emergency landings were discussed as we are the primary location for them to land since it takes less time to arrive at our airport. They do take into consideration while doing practice maneuvers for the BLM during the fire season and will avoid certain flight patterns while training to avoid delays to the BLM.

STATUS REPORT:

Terminal Project

Airport Manager, Carberry, introduced Martin Hahle, lead architect with CSHQA, who revealed modified concept drawings for review. Discussion included keeping three (3) airline offices for future use. The upcoming constructed area will have a sprinkler system in place in the new addition.

Martin Hahle, lead architect, and airport manager Carberry cautioned the Board that the design could change depending on the cost estimates that are yet to be fully estimated. The Board liked the current design concepts and look forward to the final terminal study in July.

Air Service Update

Airport Manager, Carberry discussed the new jet service (2 flights daily) which begins on June 5, 2014.

Air Magic Valley

Chair- O'Donnell discussed the hard work that is going on to develop the airshow coming in June. The group continues to look for sponsorships; and is planning events for the weekend show to include a 5K run and a bicycle race.
