- Mr. Horsley explained that it will be approximately the size of the door excluding a portion of the space for a window.

2. Treasure Valley Coffee, 301 4<sup>th</sup> Ave S – Tom Boyer/Mike Jordon

**Applicant Presentation:**

Boyd, explained the site layout for the project and the proposed materials to be used for the fencing. He explained that all of the parking spots available are being taken by the employees. He has 4-5 vans that he would like to move into this area and use it for employee parking as well. He would like to secure the area by installing a 6' fence with wiring at the top for protection.

They didn't control the project well enough and they wanted to apologize to the Commission for getting ahead of themselves on the project. They have scrapped the project for the Kiosk, the project this year is a new roof. They are working on restoration of the grain elevators before the fluff. They are also willing to provide \$500.00 for the State Anniversary Celebration. They would like to work a little closer with this Commission on projects in the future.
- John Kapolaris Twin Falls County Historic Preservation explained that they are working on creating a map of historic places and will provide a power point of the projects they have been involved with over the past 20 years.
