1. Call the meeting to order

Mayor Hall called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

**MOTION:**

Chris Talkington moved to approve the minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Greg Lanting. Roll call vote showed all members present voted in favor of the motion. Approved 3 to 0.

Greg Lanting moved to recess the meeting to North Five Points. The motion was seconded by Chris Talkington. Roll call vote showed all members present voted in favor of the motion. Approved 3 to 0.

North Five Points Park

Chris Talkington summarized discussions made by the group:

- Lighting. Prefer LED and solar lighting. Park may have access to power or near a location where power is nearby.
- Sculpture size. It should be left to the artist if the sculpture is two or three dimensional. The sculpture should be placed on a cement slab. Sculpture size shall be determined at a later date.
- Name of project. Carolyn White liked the suggestions made by Brian Olmstead, "Barren to

- Bounty, Dust to Dreams, Bones to Bounty, and Fallow to Fertile. "
- Possible public poll to determine name of project.

Carolyn White stated she has a draft proposal prepared but it is incomplete. She will need additional information from the group including the name of the proposal, budget, and brief history.

Chris Talkington stated that after the City Attorney reviews the proposal it will be presented to Council for their consideration.

The proposal will be opened up to artists in Idaho.

The next meeting will be held on August 17, 2015, at 4:00 p.m. in the Twin Falls Council Chambers.
