I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER:

1. Confirmation of quorum: Meeting Facilitator Kushlan called the meeting to order at 11:30 am. He then confirmed a quorum present
2. Williamson did a roll call and then Kushlan proceeded with the meeting.

II. CONSENT CALENDAR:

1. Approval of Minutes from the following meeting(s): **January 21, 2016, McCullum motioned to approve and Mannen 2nd the motion, approved unanimously.**

III. ITEMS OF DISCUSSION:

1. Primary Focus will be with the Engineering work for Canyon Springs Road Project Ad Hoc Information Binder from JUB Engineering along with a slide presentation by Brian Smith of JUB Engineering. Brian explained his role with JUB, also mentioned the involvement with Strata and Tim Blair who is transportation engineer with JUB. Mike Woodworth who is with Strata may join via telephone for additional questions. (See attached Power Point Presentation)
2. Kushlan, we are trying to figure out what this is going to look like and cost and how we are going to pay for this.

Comments and questions from the Committee

Mannen: Was ice a factor in the evaluation?

Woodworth: Yes, the evaluation considered water and ice on the rock fall

Novacek: Would the remediation & high scaling be on going throughout the construction phase?

Woodworth: Yes, the high scaling would occur during the construction phase, monitoring would be on going. Probably talking about a 5-10 yr. period.

Fields: How much of the canyon rim would be included in the remediation?

Woodworth- The biggest areas are up to station 300 and station 1900 would be included in the remediation.

McCullum: Is the path on the north side of the road underneath the concrete barriers?

Smith: Yes, the concrete barriers would be removed and the hill side would be excavated down to create a bench and the bench would slope, no steeper than 10%.

Lezamiz: asked about signage?

Smith: stated yes there would be looking into signage.

Novacek: have you figured anything in for lighting on that walk way?

Woodworth: said the cost does not include any additional lighting.

Virgin-Roberts: Questioned PVC/Lighting statement in packet?

Smith: yes those are things that could be added.

Novacek: was questioning possible putting camera up in the conduit at some point down the road.

Smith: Yes that is something that we could possibly look at.

Breckenridge: Questioning irrigation practices?

Woodworth: we considered that as being a contributing factor to the water flow. They feel this is far from being the cause of any of the rock fall issues we have.

Breckenridge: pointed out her concerns with the irrigation practices.

Virgin-Roberts: Commented on walking the whole area and doing GPS and wondered if some of that was still on record.

Woodworth: said that they did not identify irrigation practices as a significant contributor to the rock fall. They did not see any evidence that there was not significant water fall.

Breckenridge: stated that she would like for them to put that into the report.

Smith: ask that Katy meet with him after the meeting to show him where her concern is.

Breckenridge: Concerns about open meeting laws, and her awkwardness with the property she owns, she may want to step down.

Barigar: I appreciate your involvement and asking her to reconsider her involvement and asked if they could speak after the meeting. Does not want anyone to feel like this is an overwhelming scary process.

McCullum: said that the seep springs are a concern. Have the water issues been addressed in this research.

Smith: the scope of what we have looked at so far they have not looked for a solution at this point for the water runoff.

Woodworth: the majority of the areas we have looked at are not in the areas of high-risk.

Breckenridge: I disagree with your statement on spring activity.

Woodworth: Ok, the specific areas we noted we did not see any flowing water coming out of the rock.

Lezamiz: Concerned about the roadway safety issue. Wondering about taking the two-way stop sign and putting in a four-way stop sign?

Smith: yes that is something we can take a look at that.

Olson: has anyone thought about an alternative road going into the canyon

Mannen: maybe not another road? Maybe another walking path?

Smith: I don't know if another roadway has been evaluated or even another path. If something like that occurs is that going to address the issue we have now with the path?

Kushlan: there has been some preliminary conversation about looking at a pedestrian path down towards Auger Falls and Washington, but there has not been any specific analysis.

Barigar: curious about traffic counts and head counts, do we have any of that data?

Smith: I would say there has not been any data done recently and that is something that can be done.


Discussion:
