2. Rob inquired about extending the barrier on Shoshone Street North at the Bank of America, to prevent left hand turns from being made. Mike Sullivan advised they will be contacting the businesses in the area to see how it could have an impact on them before they make any changes.

Rob Storm had some traffic safety suggestions that Mike Sullivan will be looking into adding yield signs at the intersection of Filer at Wildrose Loop, Stadium at Morningsun, and Stadium at Cento.

Mike Sullivan will be doing a speed study on Cheney between Grandview and Washington and will give an update at the next meeting.

Rob Storm also suggested stop signs at the intersections on Cheney at NorthPine, Grace, Bradley and Anny Dr.

Orion Odendhal came to the meeting to propose having another open forum to discuss issues between motorists and bicyclists. There was a suggestion made to contact a group of bicyclist and send out announcements to discuss the issues on hand.
