MOTION:

Commissioner Ted Warren made the motion to approve the minutes for January 14, 2016. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Dennis Magill, all members present voted in favor of approving the minutes.

II. ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION:

1. Update on members needed for the Traffic Safety Commission.

Captain Hicks was unable to attend due to a meeting. SSgt. Ron Fustos advised the openings have been announced twice now and they have not been able to fill the spots. Council member Nikki Boyd mentions talking to Greg about CSI students being on the commission. Commissioner Randall Watson said he could talk to a guy that teaches drivers Ed and also mentioned talking to Idaho State Police. SSgt. Fustos said there was a media release and an advertisement on the radio and he will see if it can be posted on Facebook.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mike Sullivan advised the vegetation has been trimmed back by Denny's on Pole Line Rd. This will allow vehicles to see as they are exiting the parking lot. Commissioner Ted Warren is worried about more traffic now that Popeye's is almost finished. Mike Sullivan advised they will have to look into different signage for that area.

Commissioner Ted Warren advised people are still turning left out of the Walmart parking lot in Cheney Dr. There is a raised median and people are still going through and around the median. There was a discussion about possibly extending the island that is out there. There is also a lot of traffic due to the unfinished development going on. Mike Sullivan will take a look in the area to see what is going on.

SSgt. Ron Fustos also discussed DDACTS with is a data driven approach that keeps track of crimes and crashes that occur in certain areas. Officers will check those areas at the times the data is showing that crimes and crashes occurring.

NEW BUSINESS:

SSgt. Fustos advised Mike Sullivan has been working with concerns citizens have had with the intersection at Hwy 74 and Washington St. S. East bound and west bound drivers have been running the stop sign at that intersection. Mike talked with district 4 and they will supply a sign, "Cross traffic does not stop" warning sign, to put on their portion of the Hwy and the city will supply a sign for the city portion of the road to start educating the public. Mike advised they will have to monitor the intersection to see if this will help. When the signs are finished they will be installed.
