I. ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION

1. Call the meeting to order.

Chris Talkington brought the meeting to order at 4:12 p.m.

2. Approve the August 17, 2015, Minutes.

MOTION:

Carolyn White made a motion to approve the August 17, 2016, Minutes. The motion was seconded by Paul Smith.

The minutes will be corrected as follows: Page 3, paragraph 2: "Nancy Taylor explained that the Historic Preservation Committee met on August 17, and are in favor ~~in favor~~ of artwork at a downtown park and North Five Points."

Voice vote showed all present voted in favor of the motion.

3. Discussion and update on the art project for North Five Points triangular park.

The Committee spoke on the Request for Proposals for Call for Sculpture Artists.

Carolyn White gave an update on the RFP.

The following clarifications were made:

- The Magic Valley Arts Council will act as the facilitator/coordinator for the City of Twin Falls.
- The Welcome to Twin Falls signage will be relocated.
- A total of up to \$25,000 is available for an artist or team of artists.
- Kelly Weeks, City of Twin Falls, will be the point of contact for the City and the North Five Points Art Project Committee.

Chris Talkington stated that at previous meetings the following was discussed:

- The art project will not have moving water
- Possible placement of benches at park
- Trees will be trimmed but not removed
- Removal of the non-working drinking fountain will be discussed with Wendy Davis.

Paul Smith said he believes the project should be called an “Art Project”. The goal is to get the tour bus to stop at the location.

Nancy Taylor believes that the project should be named in the future. The Historic Preservation Commission discussed signage and are currently working in conjunction with Paul Smith on State of Idaho highway signs near the Warehouse District. She would like to see the Welcome to Twin Falls sign removed from the park and would like to see more Welcome to Twin Falls signs.

Chris Talkington asked if the Committee agreed that this should be timeless, ageless materials, no plastics, but more fundamental earth materials such as rock, stone, metals, and long lasting, low maintenance. In addition, if it has a good facing on it to have lighting on the several sides.

Carolyn White stated that the RFP, page 2, paragraph 2, describes an overview of the sculpture.

Kelly Weeks stated that the height restriction is 35’.

Carolyn White stated that the deadline date for responses will be set for the end of March.

Chris Talkington will update the Council at tonight’s meeting.
