300 Idaho artists, including welders and the CSI welding students were sent a request for proposals.

Discussion followed on Greg & Brock Bartlett's proposal #1 (horse and vintage slip scraper).

- Vintage hand pump water faucet.
- Fresnos were used to build canal systems

Discussion followed on Jacob Novinger's proposal #2 (two Native American style eagle heads).

- Low maintenance
- Modern art

Discussion followed:

- Art is to be illuminated with solar power
- Vandalism
- Fencing
- Maintenance
- Possibility requesting the artist to change the design of the fresno and hand pump water faucet in proposal #1 (*horse and vintage slip scraper*).

The Committee's consensus was to eliminate Scot Horton's proposal #3 (sculptured sign of Twin Falls).

The majority of the committee members spoke in favor of proposal #1 (horse and vintage slip scarper).

In summary, Carolyn White will contact Greg Bartlett and will recommend he modify the pump water faucet.

Wendy Davis spoke on xeriscaping in the park.

Chris Talkington clarified that a consideration of a request to approve the proposal will be presented to the City Council at a future meeting.

Chris Talkington called the meeting to order at 2:31 p.m.

2. Discussion on an update on the art project for the North Five Points triangular park. *Discussion/Possible Action*

Committee discussion followed.

-Drive by exhibit.

-First impression of what water has done for our valley.

-Landscaping to demonstrate desert to improved land

Paul Smith explained that he and members of the Twin Falls Canal Company (TFCC) have discussed the proposed art. Paul Smith explained that a fresno scraper is a machine pulled by horses used for constructing canals and ditches. An authentic fresno scraper and chains to clean ditches would be offered to the artist.

Brian Olmstead explained that the TFCC would be able to build an actual

ditch at no cost. Having the ditch bank grass is optional. The horse pulling the implement simulates water. Another option would be to incorporate a head gate in the design.

Don Hall explained that he is in favor of Xeriscaping landscaping reducing the need for supplemental water from irrigation.

Greg Lanting explained that a head gate could be placed in the back of the canal.

Chris Talkington explained that interpretive signs could be placed at the location for educational purposes.

Those in attendance unanimously agreed of the proposed revisions to the artist's renderings.

In summary, Carolyn White will have Brian Olmstead meet with the artist with the ideas presented.
