Commission member Randall Watson called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m. There is a conformation of a quorum present.

CONSIDERATION OF THE AMENDMENTS TO THE AGENDA: None

I. CONSENT CALENDAR:

1. Consideration of the minutes for May 12, 2016.

MOTION:

Commissioner Ted Warren made the motion to approve the minutes for May 12, 2016. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Dennis Magill, all commission members present voted to approve the minutes.

II. ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION:

1. Proposed striping plan for Grandview Dr. at the new school:

Michael Sullivan discussed the striping plan. Engineering approved striping on Grandview Dr. from Canyon Rim Rd. to Pole Line Rd. In the area of Federation Rd., they will put in arrow bays for a right turn lane. This will leave a wide shoulder for the school area.

2. Review the school drawings for traffic flow at the two new schools going up.

Brady Dickinson said there does not seem to be a lot of concern at Rock Creek School. The biggest issue at Rock Creek School, is that it is not finished and constructions going on. Brady Dickinson is not concerned much with the traffic at

Pillar Falls Elementary school. He said Stadium Blvd. would have to be utilized. The bigger challenge will be the potential foot traffic for Pillar Falls Elementary. They will be providing safety bussing for Pillar Falls Elementary. His concern is at Hankins and Falls and foot traffic.

OLD BUSINESS:

Brady Dickinson advised the School Board Chairman, Bernie Jansen with the school board is interested in serving on the Committee.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ted Warren wanted to bring up concerns on the North College Rd. near the yield sign. Coming out of CSI near Fillmore St. Michael Sullivan will look at the visibility on the approach.

Jackie Fields discussed the traffic on Blue Lakes at Canyon West. It used to be called Perrine and is now abandoned. Planning and Zoning is concerned for the potential accidents that may occur at that location. Michael Sullivan and Jackie Fields have discussed adjusting the traffic signals to prevent traffic congestion. They have also talked with the Idaho Transportation Department about ways to improve the traffic flow, including correlating timing on the Golf Course Rd. with the traffic timing on Bridgeview Blvd. and Fillmore St. Dennis Magill and Brady Dickinson agree this would be worthy of discussion with ITD with subsequent discussion with the Planning and Zoning and the Traffic Safety Commission. Ted Warren would like to see a map of the area as well as ask Planning and Zoning to discuss this with the Commission.

MOTION:

Ted Warren made a motion to ask staff bring a map to a future meeting to discuss the traffic on Blue Lakes at Canyon West they recommend the City Council reaches out to ITD. Dennis Magill seconded the motion. All present were in favor.
