Approval of April 2016 Minutes

Carberry, Airport Manager, discussed the City of Twin Falls Comprehensive Plan update. The City is undergoing an update to its comprehensive plan. Idaho State Code now requires all comprehensive plans to discuss any airports that they may have in their jurisdiction. Carberry requested volunteers to join in on a discussion with the City and County officials to discuss planning and zoning issues related to the airport and the policies, goals and objectives for planning appropriately to protect the airport from incompatible land use encroachment in the future. Steve Kolar and Mark Cutler have volunteered to attend the upcoming meeting which will be led by the consultant writing the aviation chapter in the comprehensive plan.

Status Reports

Carberry, Airport Manager, gave an update on airport projects, the terminal is running on schedule. The airline and the TSA have adapted to the phasing plan requiring them to utilize temporary facilities. The Fed EX project is moving smoothly. The detention pond is being dug and the fill s utilized for the building pad site.

Mashaal gave an overview of the upcoming fly-in. He discussed keeping the Fly-in event small and will be seeking volunteers to assist.
