**Item #1      Welcome and Introductions**

**Item #3      Discussion of Meeting with Citizen Finance Committee**

Chris Clark asked if there was a timeline for getting meetings scheduled. Dennis will e-mail the Citizen Finance Committee to see if they can attend the meeting on April 17<sup>th</sup>. Scot McNeley suggested having e-mails sent out from each sub-committee to members of each committee on what was discussed at each meeting.

**Item #4      Other Items from the Committee**

Mitch Humble went over the results from the National Citizen Survey. There were three questions that pertained to Parks and Recreation and based on the results from the survey, we would not have the number of voters to pass a bond for a recreation center. He wanted to point that out to the committee so they know that education is the key in promoting to build a recreation center and get the majority of voters to approve it.
