Kathy,  
Could you add this agenda item to the November meeting? The problem is that a realtor off of Julie Lane (the red "X" in the attached aerial view) has occasional seminars held in their office that generates a lot of traffic. Very often the overflow parking extends onto Julie Ln. The area circled in red. Julie Ln. is only 36' wide and when cars are parked on both sides that leaves only about 12' for two-way traffic to get thru. This is a safety concern to the residents in the nearby subdivision. The City proposed posting this area as "No Parking" but the realtor is not happy about that so we are holding off on the signs until we can resolve this at the meeting. Nancy Glaesemann is the realtor and she would like to attend to express her concerns. We may get some residents to attend also.

Could you forward all this to the members so they can review this ahead of the meeting?
