## These are the rules:

- To have rabbits or fowl, the applicant must have at least 5,000 square feet of property for each 25 fowl or for more than three up to 25 rabbits. In addition, the applicant must have a rabbit run or enclosure located no closer than 40 feet from a neighbor's dwelling.
- To keep one cow, one horse, one sheep or one goat, or any other animals except dogs and cats, the applicant must have at least one acre of property and at least ten thousand (10,000) square feet of real property or pastureland devoted exclusively for the use of each animal. The fencing must be constructed and maintained to prevent the animals from going upon adjoining properties in any manner whatsoever.
- The Code Enforcement Department prior to the issuance of a permit may inspect places and premises where any of the animals are kept or housed.
- Animal locations, structures, pens, corrals and any other premises or structure used for the keeping of horses, cows, sheep, goats, rabbits, chickens, doves and pigeons or any other animals must be kept in clean and sanitary conditions, free from obnoxious odors and substances. All animals shall be kept confined. Animals or fowl cannot create a disturbance to the residents in the particular locality by creating any noise, odor or damage to the adjacent property.
- For the purpose of selling, loading and shipping any horses, cows, pigs, hogs, goats, sheep or chickens, it shall be lawful to keep the same in loading pens provided for said purpose, but no such animals shall be kept in such pens within the corporate limits of the city for a period of more than 36 hours except by written permission of the Code Enforcement Department.
